

SHARE OF AFT IN DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AND FIXED CAPITAL FORMATION (%)





LOGISTICS PERFORMANCE INDICES (LPI) (1-5)




TRADE FACILITATION INDICATORS, 2017 (0-2)





TRADE COSTS (ad-valorem, %)




